DC License Renewals

Renewals have been completed with over 95% of our licenses being renewed. Total licensed DCs 2149.

Rules Updates

We are in the process of updating several rules, including:

21 NCAC 10 .0304 DESIGNATION OF SPECIALTIES REVISION

Allows the board to recognize new specialty designations that are equivalent to Diplomate status.

21 NCAC 10 .0103 STRUCTURE OF BOARD

Changes to accommodate online elections.

21 NCAC 10 .0203 NORTH CAROLINA EXAMINATION

Changes to allow for online Jurisprudence exam.

21 NCAC 10 .0216 WAIVER

Changes to allow the board to adapt to new or unexpected circumstances.

21 NCAC 10 .0207 CONTINUING EDUCATION SEMINARS

Allows for the auto approval of CE seminars sponsored by certain organizations.

Pending Rule Changes

We are working on the CCA program to better align the curriculum and administer it as one program instead of two separate programs. Going forward, the new terminology will be:

CCA Level I – Clinical

CCA Level II - Xray

Legislation

We are also expecting our legislative modernization bill to be introduced soon. Once it is introduced we can share it publicly.
